Owner's Manual



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WARNING

To guard against injury, basic safety precautions should be observed including the following:


READ ALL SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE USE. WARNING

To avoid electric shock, special care should be taken since water is employed in the use of aquarium equipment. For each of the following situations, do not attempt to repair yourself. Return the appliance to an authorized service facility for service or discard the appliance.

- If the appliance falls into water, DO NOT reach for it! First unplug it an then retrieve it. If the electrical components of the appliance get wet, unplug the appliance immediately.
- Carefully examine the appliance after installation. It should not be plugged in if there is water on parts not intended to be wet.
- Do not operate any appliance if it has a damaged cord or plug, or if it is malfunctioning or if it is dropped or damaged in any manner.

To avoid the possibility of the appliance plug or receptacle getting

wet, position aquarium to one side of a wall mounted receptacle to prevent water from dripping onto the receptacle plug. A "Drip Loop" should be arranged by the user for EACH cord connecting an aquarium appliance to a receptacle. The "Drip Loop" is that part of the cord below the level of the receptacle or the connector if an extension cord is used. This "Drip Loop" prevents water travelling along the cord and



coming in contact with the receptacle. If the plug or the receptacle do get wet DO NOT unplug the cord. Disconnect the fuse to the circuit breaker that supplies power to the appliance. Then unplug and examine for the presence of water in the receptacle.


- Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used by or near children.
- To avoid injury, do not contact moving parts or hot parts such as heaters, reflectors, lamps bulbs and etc.
- Always unplug an appliance from the outlet when not in use, before putting on or taking off parts, and before cleaning. Never yank the cord to pull plug from outlet. Grasp the plug and pull to disconnect.

- Do not use an appliance for other than intended use. The use of attachments not recommended or sold by the appliance manufacturer may case an unsafe condition.
- Do not install or store the appliance where it will be exposed to the weather or to temperatures below freezing.
- Make sure an appliance mounted on a tank is securely installed before operating it.
- Read and observe all the important notices on the appliance.
- This appliance has a polarized plug (one blade is wider than the other). As a safety feature, this plug will fit in a polarized outlet only one way. If the plug does not fit fully in the outlet, reverse the plug. If it still does not fit, contact a qualified electrician. Never use with an extension cord unless plug can be fully inserted. Do not attempt to defeat this safety feature.
- This appliance is intended FOR HOUSEHOLD USE ONLY.
- If an extension cord is necessary, a cord with a proper rating should be used.

CLEANING

- It is important to keep the SkkyeLight Utility Light clean.
- Always unplug the Utility Light before performing maintenance or cleaning.
- Wipe exposed surfaces carefully with a damp cloth to remove any dust or mineral deposits which may collect over time.
- Make sure hands are dry before re-plugging into an approved electrical outlet




- Utility 6 mounts on the outside of the aquarium/sump.

UTILITY LIGHT AS REFUGIUM LIGHT ON A ALL—IN—ONE AQUARIUM




- Utility 6 mounts on the outside of the AIO Aquarium
- Position the Utility Light Head over the desired area to be illuminated.


MOUNTING SKYYELIGHT UTILITY 6

 Make sure lever is opened. (Fig. 2)





- Press evenly on the Suction Cup Mount.

POSITIONING GOOSENECK ARM




 Do not bend GooseNeck at joint where arm is attached to the Suction Cup Mount or LED Light Head.(Fig.4 & Fig.5)







Do not Bend GooseNeck arm at a Sharp 90deg. (Fig 7 & Fig 8).






• Bend GooseNeck at a gradual 90deg.(Fig9 & Fig10)





POWERING UP UTILITY 6

- Utility 6 Comes with a single 6W Driver
- Once you have positioned your Utility Light to the desire location you are now ready to power up the Utility 6
